Order Entry

Designed to function as the gateway to other modules, Order Entry provides your staff with the tools needed to communicate effectively. From placing orders with ancillary departments to verifying the status of orders, Order Entry enhances accuracy and efficiency, freeing your staff from clerical work and allowing them to focus on better patient care. Our forms design feature allows receiving departments to eliminate forms cost normally associated with pre-printed forms. Sample departments supported from order entry include radiology, laboratory, respiratory therapy, physical therapy, outpatient surgery and dietary.

Laboratory

Designed by lab personnel, pathologists and data processing professionals, this module maximizes control over the flow of work in and out of the laboratory. Implementation of the Laboratory module offers staff significant improvements in productivity and efficiency. The module is fully integrated with Order Entry and analytical instruments in the laboratory. Therefore orders flow straight from nursing service to the applicable instrument. Bar code labels are generated as a by-product of the order, allowing specimens to be gathered and then tracked automatically for testing, results reporting and patient account billing.

Patient Scheduling

Designed as a flexible appointment scheduling solution for patient appointments and activities within the facility, Patient Scheduling provides the tools needed to effectively manage departmental staff and resources.

Pharmacy

The Pharmacy System is an easy-to-use inpatient order entry system for fast, accurate order processing. Information used for billing is obtained from each order. Each patient is then charged, and the distribution and return of drugs are recorded. This information is stored by the system and is available to a powerful set of drug utilization review programs. New orders are checked for drug-to-drug and allergy-to-drug interaction. The interactions are displayed immediately and printed on the appropriate reports. Finally, the pharmacy system is completely integrated with other modules, giving you real time access to Patient Census and other clinical information.

Radiology

Because this module is fully integrated with Order Entry, received orders automatically create or add to the patient film index, produce film flash cards, folder labels and interface documents for use in transcription. Once the order is completed, films can be tracked automatically for location, results reporting and patient account billing.
